I was in my last semester of a long educational journey to become a dental hygienist. My husband and I have 2 daughters who were 9 and 13 at the time. I was terrified that I would not live to see our daughters grow up, graduate, and start their own lives. Our family had already made huge financial sacrifices for me to go to school, and now that hardship was going to be that much more difficult with extended unemployment while having aggressive treatment and surgeries for over a year. We were who **Breast Cancer Foundation of the Ozarks** was designed for. **BCFO** provides funds for mammograms, and they provide financial assistance for patients who are going through treatment and their families. I am happy to report that after a long journey I am now a 15-year breast cancer survivor and I have seen my 2 daughters graduate from high school and college. We also recently watched our older daughter walk down the aisle and added a son to our family. Life is GOOD! Janelle O'Neill*
